From The Pastor

Later in October we will combine appeals for the Church in Eastern and Central Europe as well as Latin America. The request to support European communities came after the fall of communism in those nations which had been under communist control since the end of the Second World War.

Here is an example. After the fall of communism in Romania, virtually none of the Greek Catholic Churches were returned. Under communist control these buildings and other properties were seized and given to the Orthodox Church. In the diocese (or properly the eparchy) of Cluj-Gherla construction began on a new cathedral dedicated to the martyrs and confessors of the last century. With support from outside Romania the project should be ready for dedication in 2018. It will serve not only need for worship, but also house a library, conference hall, and a place for children's activities.

Years of communist control saw a rise of atheism and decline of moral virtues (honesty, keeping promises, respect for elderly, love of country). Moral education and Catholic religious instruction are carried on by local people but sometimes they are unable to finance the upkeep of churches and religious school. Pray for our brothers and sisters who themselves or their parents have suffered for the faith.
