From The Pastor

Mission. We invite everyone to take part in the parish mission Feb. 11-14. Father Greg Schmitt will preach the mission. Daily Mass will be offered at 8AM with the mission talk at 7PM. This includes Ash Wednesday when a longer sermon will be part of the beginning of Lent. A free will offering will be taken each evening. Father will stay with the Sisters in the rectory.

But what is a mission? The word means a sending, as Jesus said to the apostles before He departed from them at the Ascension. "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." (Matthew 28:19-20) The task of the apostles (and those who believe due to their preaching) is to spread the good news of Jesus for the salvation of the world. The mission of the Church is to protect and spread the deposit of faith, the sum total of all that Jesus revealed and entrusted to the Church: creed, commandments and sacraments.

Mission also means an individual task such as the mission of a priest to preach the gospel. It can be the task of a student to master a subject. It can be achieving some temporary but worthwhile goal. It can be the work of men and women who travel to foreign lands to bring them salvation in Christ as we take up collections for the missions.

Blessing of throats will be given after weekend Masses (Feb. 3-4). Saint Blaise was a martyr in Armenia who prayed for deliverance of a child from harm from swallowing a fish bone. We all seek God's blessing in the face of winter illness.
